## Holy Father's Intention for September 2016

**Universal: Centrality of the Human Person**

That each may contribute to the common good and to the building of a society that places the human person at the center.

**Evangelization: Mission to Evangelize**

That by participating in the Sacraments and meditating on Scripture, Christians may become more aware of their mission to evangelize.

## **The path of Virtue: Prudence, the charioteer of the Virtues; From Boys to Men, Ch 2.**

1. Prudence is the virtue that directs all the other virtues!
2. Definition: "Prudence" is the virtue that disposes practical reason to discern our true good in every circumstance and to choose the right means of achieving it" (CCC 1806). Prudence is almost synonymous with wisdom. Wisdom calls out to everyone. It is not just for an elite (See Prov. 1:22). "Prudence guides one to do the right thing, at the right time, and in the right way.
3. St Thomas breaks up prudence into three key steps: counsel, judgment and decisiveness. One first seeks counsel from those who are prudent, experienced, and knowledgeable regarding the matter at hand. Counsel involves gathering all the information and advice that is necessary for making a right decision (See Prov 15:22).
4. Judgment is the second step. Judgment is the ability to apply all relevant principles and facts to the decision at hand (See Sirach 32:18-19).
5. Action. For Saint Thomas Aquinas, one must not only know what the right path is through prudence, but one must be decisive in acting on that knowledge.
6. Again, for St Thomas, "The prudent man judges everything in view of its end (its final purpose) and then he ultimately makes the right decisions because he has the final end in mind. Two points: This makes clear that prudent judgements cannot be made on the basis of emotions or feelings. These usually confuse the final end. Nor does this process allow us to say that the end justifies the means. The means must be moral in and of themselves. We cannot do evil in order to achieve the good.

## **El camino de la virtud: La prudencia, el conductor del carro de las virtudes; Gray y Martin, Ch 2.**

1. ¡La prudencia es la virtud que dirige todas las demás virtudes!
2. Definición: "La prudencia" es la virtud que dispone la razón práctica a discernir nuestro verdadero bien en todas las circunstancias y de elegir los medios rectos para realizarlo "(CIC 1806). La prudencia es casi sinónimo de sabiduría. La sabiduría dice en voz alta a todo el mundo. No se trata sólo de una élite (Ver Prov. 1:22). "La prudencia guía a uno a hacer lo correcto, en el momento adecuado y de la manera correcta.
3. St. Thomas describe la prudencia en tres pasos clave: consejo, juicio y decisión. Primer hay que buscar el consejo de los que son prudentes, experimentados y bien informados sobre el asunto en cuestión. Consejo implica la recopilación de toda la información y el asesoramiento que sea necesario para tomar una decisión correcta (ver Prov 15:22).
4. El juicio es el segundo paso. El juicio es la capacidad de aplicar los principios y hechos relevantes para la decisión en cuestión (Ver Eclesiástico 32: 18-19).
5. Acción: Para Santo Tomás de Aquino, uno no sólo debe saber cuál es el camino correcto es a través de la prudencia, pero hay que ser decisivo para actuar sobre ese conocimiento.
6. Una vez más, para St Thomas, "el hombre discreto, juzga todo en vista de su fin (su propósito final) y luego en última instancia toma las decisiones correctas porque tiene el fin final en mente. Dos puntos: Esto deja en claro que los juicios prudentes no pueden hacerse sobre la base de las emociones o sentimientos. Estos por lo general confunden el fin último. Tampoco este proceso nos permite decir que el fin justifica los medios. Los medios deben ser morales en sí mismos.
