October 9:

Thank You, Sorry, Excuse Me

Saying “thank you” is such an easy thing, and yet so hard! How often do we say “thank you” to one another in our families? These are essential words for our life in common. “Sorry,” “thank you.” If families can say these three things, they will be fine. “Sorry,” “excuse me,” “thank you.” How often do we say “thank you” in our families? How often do we say “thank you” to those who help us, those close to us, those at our side throughout life? All too often we take everything for granted! This happens with God, too.

Reflection: The words sorry, excuse me, and thank you are words that can help you be merciful or receive mercy from others. Who needs to hear you say “sorry,” “excuse me,” and “thank you”? In what areas of your life do you need to say these things to God?

He Wasted All the Money

Let us recall that beautiful parable of the son who left his home with the money of his inheritance. He wasted all the money and the, when he had nothing left, he decided to return home, not as a son but as a servant. His heart was filled with so much guilt and shame. The surprise came when he began to speak, to ask for forgiveness; his father did not let him speak, he embraced him, he kissed him, and he began to make merry. But I am telling you: Each time we go to confession, God embraces us. God rejoices!

Reflection: Do you have guilt and shame in you life right now? Are you afraid of what God thinks of you? Consider the story of the Prodigal Son (also called the story of the Merciful Father). God is waiting to embrace you, not condemn you.
