Let us listen to what God's word teaches us about mercy, and allow that word to resound in the life for the Church. The gospel tells us, "Blessed are the merciful, because they shall obtain mercy." (Mt 7:7).

Reflection:

It's in giving that we receive. When we make acts of mercy, we in turn receive mercy, both from the person we help and from God. Allow yourself to really hear the cry of the needy, whether within your own home, neighborhood, or the larger world.
