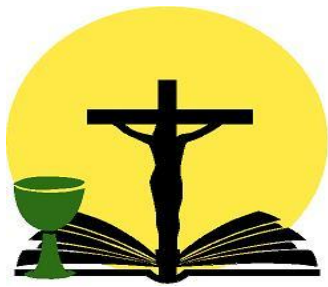

The Youth class for Jr High and High School are about to start classes with Father Paul Wednesday Evenings during CCD Class. We will be discussing Dating and understanding our sexuality using the book, “How to find your soulmate without losing your soul.” **Please encourage your student to join us these next two weeks. How important is it to become capable of teaching? St. Paul along with our Bishop felt it is very important.
