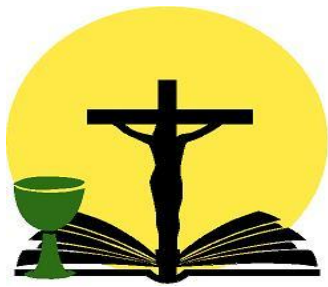

How important is it to become capable of teaching? St. Paul along with our Bishop felt it is very important. Hebrews 5: 11-14 About this we have much to say, and it is difficult to explain, for you have become sluggish in hearing, Although you should be teachers by this time, you need to have someone teach you again the basic elements of the utterances of God. You need milk, not solid food. Everyone who lives on milk lacks experience of the word of righteousness, for he is a child. But solid food is for the mature, for those whose faculties are trained by practice to discern good and evil.

Mary's Gaze

Mary's gaze! How important this is! How many things can we say with a look! Affection, encouragement, compassion, love, but also disapproval, envy, pride, and even hatred. Often a look says more than words; it says what words do not or not say.

At whom is the Virgin Mary looking? She is looking at each and every one of us. And how does she look at us? She looks at us as a Mother, with tenderness, mercy, and love.

Reflection: What does your look say about you? Do you look upon others with mercy, or does your glance convey a sense of disapproval, or superiority, or boredom? Take up Mary's example and look on others with love.

Father Paul would like to get at least to 90 families, which is half of what we have on record. Thank you very much for your generous response.
6. We will be obtaining the Catholic education on-line resources from "FORMED", from the Augustine Institute in the near future. Keep your eyes open for great resources. "FORMED" is a wonderful tool for individuals, children, teens, and families.
