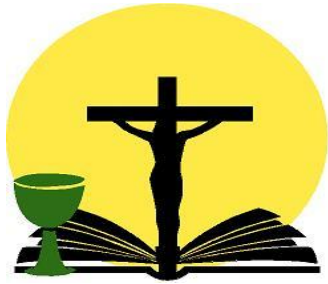

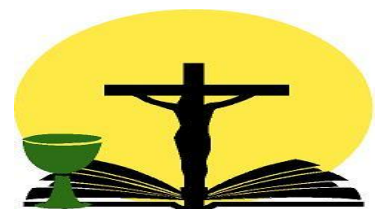
Youth News – Invite Your Friends To Join Us On Our Summer Journey Towards Excellence

How important is it to become capable of teaching? St Paul along with our Bishop feel it is very important! See Hebrews 5:11-14:

“About this we have much to say, and it is difficult to explain, for you have become sluggish in hearing, Although you should be **teachers** by this time, you need to have someone teach you again the basic elements of the utterances of God. You need milk, not solid food. Everyone who lives on milk lacks experience of the word of righteousness, for he is a child. But solid food is for the mature, for those whose faculties are trained by practice to discern good and evil.”

Christian Stewardship takes a positive view of money. It sees money not only as a medium of exchange but a symbol of the person who has it. We reveal something of who we are by the way we acquire it, use it, and share it.



The First Step

Being a disciple means being constantly ready to bring the love of Jesus to others... The first step is personal dialogue, when the other person speaks and shares his or her joys, hopes, and concerns for loved ones, or so many other heartfelt needs. Only afterward is it possible to bring up God's word, perhaps by reading a Bible verse or relating a story, but always keeping in mind the fundamental message: the personal love of God who became man, who gave himself up for us, who is living and who offers us his salvation and his friendship.

Reflection: When we think of evangelization, we have to first think of mercy, How can we care for the person with whom we are talking? How can we listen to their joys, hopes, and concerns? Start with mercy in introducing them to our merciful Father?
