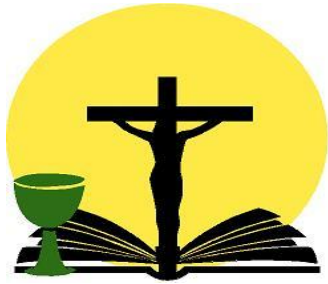

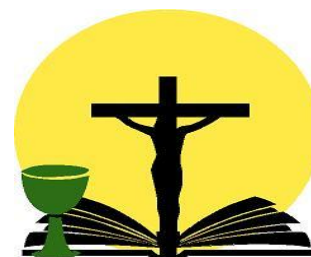
Youth News – Invite Your Friends To Join Us On Our Summer Journey Towards Excellence

“About this we have much to say, and it is difficult to explain, for you have become sluggish in hearing, Although you should be **teachers** by this time, you need to have someone teach you again the basic elements of the utterances of God. You need milk, not solid food. Everyone who lives on milk lacks experience of the word of righteousness, for he is a child. But solid food is for the mature, for those whose faculties are trained by practice to discern good and evil.”

The Will to Share

In the Eucharist Jesus does not give just any bread, but the bread of eternal life, he gives himself, offering himself to the Father out of love for us. But we must go to the Eucharist with those sentiments of Jesus, which are compassion and the will to share. One who goes to the Eucharist without having compassion for the needy and without sharing is not at ease with Jesus.

Reflection: Is there a relationship between the sacraments and your service to the poor? Do they spur you on to serve others? Does receiving these gifts of mercy compel you to share this mercy with others? Take time after Mass this week to ask God how he wants you to share his mercy with those in need.
