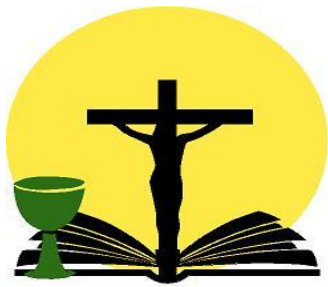

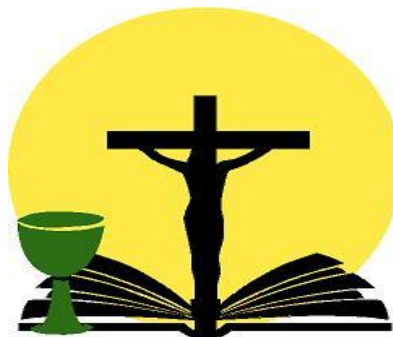
**Youth News – Invite Your Friends To Join Us On Our Summer Journey Towards Excellence**

“About this we have much to say, and it is difficult to explain, for you have become sluggish in hearing, Although you should be **teachers** by this time, you need to have someone teach you again the basic elements of the utterances of God. You need milk, not solid food. Everyone who lives on milk lacks experience of the word of righteousness, for he is a child. But solid food is for the mature, for those whose faculties are trained by practice to discern good and evil.”

## The Breath of Faith (Feast of Our Lady of The Rosary)

Prayer is the breath of faith: in a relationship of trust, in a relationship of love, dialogue cannot be left out, and prayer is the dialogue of the soul with God. October is also the month of the Rosary, and on this first Sunday it is tradition to recite the Prayer to Our Lady of Pompeii, the Blessed Virgin Mary of the Most Holy Rosary. Let us join spiritually together in this act of trust in our Mother and let us receive from her hands the crown of the Rosary: The Rosary is a school of prayer; the Rosary is a school of faith!

**Reflection:** Look up and recite the Prayer of our Lady of Pompeii. In this month of the Rosary, make a resolution to pray the Rosary, whether once a month, once a week, or even once a day.
