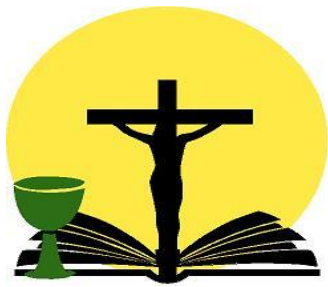

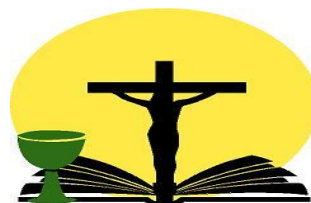

What is the sign that we are on the right path? Scripture tells us: defend the oppressed; take care of your neighbor, the sick, the poor, the needy, the ignorant. This is the touchstone. Hypocrites cannot do this, for they are so full of themselves that they are blind to seeing others. [But] when one journeys a little and draws near the Lord, the light of the Father enables one to see these things and to go out to help one's brothers and sisters.

Reflection: What does it mean to be spiritual hypocrite? Where are you a hypocrite in your own life? How can you get back on the right path?
